### Small Craft Harbour Modernization Project

- CAO provided an update that the ladder installation is currently on hold with DFO
- Commissioners commented on the need for public input in early 2016, as installation is scheduled for between February and September, 2016
- Commissioners expressed concern regarding narrowing of the channel and need for ability to manoeuver to remove any bottlenecks
- CAO provided a general update on the project status and need for Council to pass resolutions approving the breakwater project plans
- Clr. Oliwa discussed leveraging the value of the breakwater asset to procure grant funding from third parties
- CAO provided information on application from Island West and its potential to impact the District's application
- Clr. Oliwa discussed desire for power to be supplied at Otter Street Wharf
- CAO provided an update that a working group meeting with DFO would be arranged for January, 2016

The Harbour Authority received questions and comments from the public re:


- Desire from Harbour Advisory Commission to provide input into fees and charges bylaw for use of Small Craft Harbour

- Desire from Harbour Advisory Commission to install a locked gate to prevent large vehicles from driving on the docks and causing prematurely wear
- Update on whether the Coast Guard Auxiliary shed will be receiving renovations
- Update on the installation of signage in Small Craft Harbour
- Clarification on appropriate parking areas for boat trailers and harbour users, and if enforcement would be beneficial
- Request to look into flooding concern in the east end of the Small Craft Harbour parking lot
- Clarification on how District responds to oil spills
