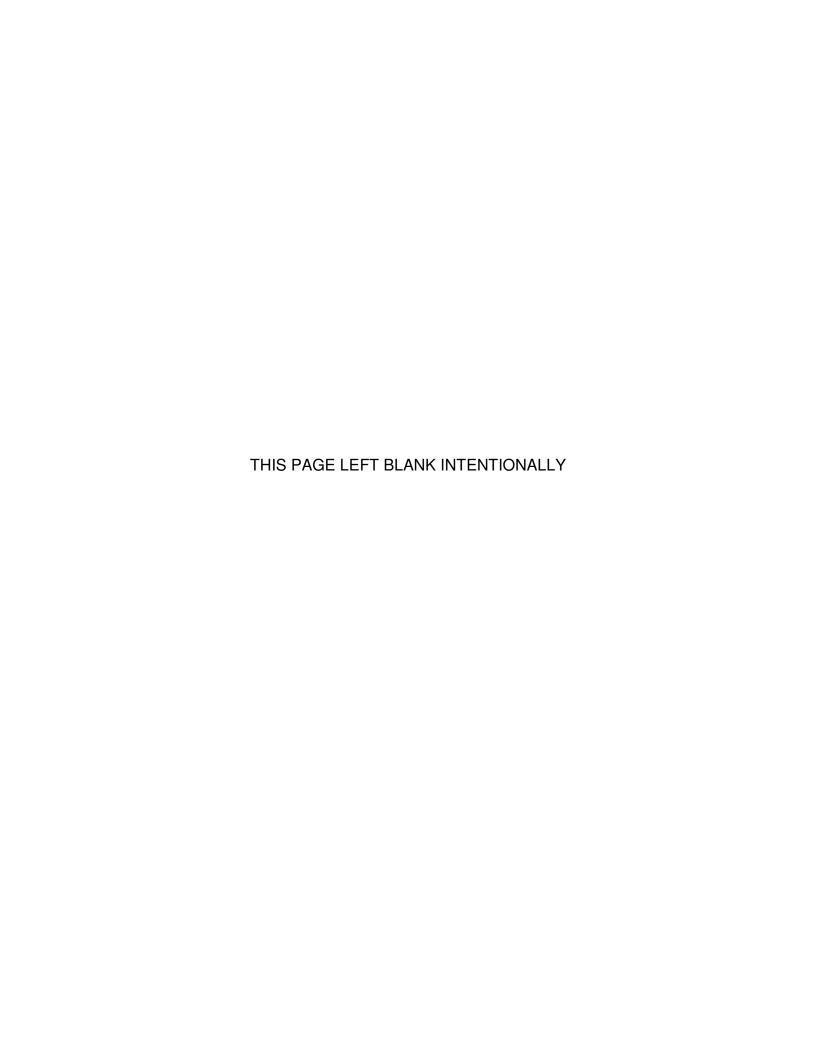

I-2 Small Craft Harbour - Catamaran Scope of Work

Chairperson Parlee and Commissioner Charnell summarized the information presented at the working group meeting May 4, 2016. They reported Small Craft Harbour is ready to proceed with the installation of the catamarans in late June or early July 2016. The catamaran drawings were examined and discussed by the Commission members.

Once the first stage of the catamaran is installed, the District of Ucluelet will be in the positon to seek funding for the connector docks illustrated in the second phase drawings.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this report is to provide background and/or feasibility information, where necessary, to the Harbour Authority on the recommendations made by Harbour Advisory Commission at their May 4, 2016 meeting.

MOTIONS FROM THE MAY 4, 2016 HARBOUR ADVISORY COMMISSION MEETING:

The below motions are listed with numbers to facilitate convenient referencing only. Staff comments are in blue.

1 Moved by Commissioner Gudbranson and seconded by Commissioner Winpenny to recommend to the Harbour Authority to approve the installation of the catamarans as presented at the working committee.

(Kimoto opposed) CARRIED

2 Moved by Commissioner Charnell seconded by Commissioner Alexander to express concern to the Harbour Authority regarding access to our facility in light of Wonderful Holdings Water Lease and further, to recommend the Harbour Authority be kept apprised of all negotiations between DFO and the province regarding the water lease to Wonderful Holdings. (47.04)

CARRIED

All parties mentioned are already in cooperative communication.

3 Moved by Commissioner Charnell and seconded by Commissioner Gudbranson to recommend to the Harbour Authority that dog waste bags be installed at the Pat Leslie Boat launch and in the inner basin; that the boat launch area be graded to remove pot holes, that better signage for parallel parking be installed at the boat launch and there be signs installed regarding parking time limit signs installed at the Pat Leslie boat launch

CARRIED

Dog waste bag dispensers have been installed at both the Pat Leslie Boat Launch (one) and two more have been installed at SCH.

The boat launch area was graded the week of May 09, 2016, after the new docks were installed.

Signage for the Pat Leslie boat launch is being looked at.

4 Moved by Commissioner Gudbranson and seconded by Commissioner Kimoto to recommend to the Harbour Authority to investigate the cost of installing five new fingers for reserved berthage and moorage and the renewal of the existing fingers at dock A with cost recovery options for maintenance of the existing docks.

CARRIED

The cost of each new finger was approximately \$1,800 two to three years ago. There are 15 fingers presently at Dock A.

One cost recovery option would to be to increase to the basic rates for reserved berthage and moorage to cover the costs of the new fingers and to be able to put money away for their maintenance. Or, maybe a surcharge would be a better option. Maybe HAC could suggest some other cost recovery options for the maintenance of the existing docks.

5 Moved by Commissioner Winpenny and seconded by Commissioner to recommend to the Harbour Authority that they explore the extension of the public walkway with the new owners of the Canadian Princess as it was originally planned to follow the inner basin to the Water's Edge property.
