Harbour Activities-

The harbour has been steady with the Trawl hake fishery starting early and strong. We have had 12 trawlers working off our dock from the beginning of April. We also have had 3 cod deliveries

to Hub City Seafoods off the Whiskey Dock. May 3rd was the area G Salmon opening. The beginning of May brought us the return of some of the charter vessel fleet. We have 9 fishing charter vessels in the basin with 3 nature charter vessels and an additional 3 more non fishing charter vessels on the Whiskey dock.
